On May 3, 2022, Casella Waste Systems, Inc. (the "Company") announced an offering of up to \$60.0 million aggregate principal amount of Vermont Economic Development Authority (the "Issuer") Solid Waste Disposal Revenue Bonds (Casella Waste Systems, Inc. Project) Series 2022. (the "Bonds") under an indenture between the Issuer and the bond trustee (the "Indenture"). Initially, \$35.0 million in principal amount of Bonds is anticipated to be issued under the Indenture. One or more additional tranches of Bonds, in the aggregate principal amount of up to \$25.0 million (the "Additional Bonds"), may be issued under the Indenture in the future, subject to the terms and conditions of the Indenture. The Bonds, during any term interest rate period, will be guaranteed by substantially all of the Company's subsidiaries (the "Guarantors"), as required by the terms of the loan agreement pursuant to which the Issuer will loan the proceeds of the Bonds to the Company.

The exact terms and timing of the offering of the Bonds and any Additional Bonds will depend upon market conditions and other factors. There can be no assurance that the offering will be completed.

The Bonds will not be a general obligation of the Issuer and will not constitute indebtedness of or a charge against the general credit of the Issuer. The Bonds will not be a debt of the State of Vermont and will be payable solely from amounts received from the Company under the terms of the Indenture.

Pursuant to the announced offering, the Bonds will be offered only to qualified institutional buyers as defined in Rule 144A under the Securities Act of 1933, as amended (the "Securities Act").

The Bonds will not be registered under the Securities Act and may not be offered or sold in the United States absent registration or an applicable exemption from the registration requirements of the Securities Act and other applicable securities laws.

RUTLAND, Vermont, May 3, 2022-- Casella Waste Systems, Inc. ("<u>Casella</u>") (NASDAQ:CWST), a regional solid waste, recycling and resource management services company, today announced an offering of up to \$60.0 million aggregate principal amount of Vermont Economic Development Authority (the "<u>Issuer</u>") Solid Waste Disposal Revenue Bonds (Casella Waste Systems, Inc. Project) Series 2022 (the "<u>Bonds</u>") under an indenture between the Issuer and the bond trustee (the "<u>Indenture</u>").
